



## DESCRIPTION OF MATERIALS

- **Non-woven fabric** created by bonding polypropylene fibers together to prevent the formation of micropores, resulting in outer and inner layers impervious to gaseous substances. Polypropylene is a flexible and light-weight synthetic fiber that has the following characteristics: hydrophobic, breathable, bacteriostatic, hypoallergenic, stain-proof, mildew resistant, and dirt resistant.

- **ePTFE membrane**: a durable, microporous membrane impervious to liquids and water vapor, but that still allows the user to breathe easily. Also, the membrane is hydrophobic, meaning that it prevents droplets of saliva from settling on the material. The ePTFE membrane used in these masks has been approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA) as a material compatible with the human body.


